

Pianist Keiko Alexander is a graduate of the Aichi University of Fine Arts in Nagoya, Japan, and the Juilliard School in New York, where she studied with Sascha Gorodnitzki and Janina Fialkowska. Her other teachers have included Bela Siki in Cincinnati and Vlado Perlemuter in Paris.

Ms. Alexander lived in Cincinnati, Ohio for sixteen years, where she performed extensively as a member of Alexis Piano Trio which consisted of members of the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra. She also taught at the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music Preparatory Department and served as a head of the piano department. In 2000, Ms. Alexander moved to Vancouver, Canada, where she taught at the VSO School of Music, performed throughout the region as a chamber musician, held master classes, judging domestic and international competitions, and performed 8 piano ensemble concerts in Vancouver and Germany.

In spring, 2015, Ms. Alexander moved to Chicago, and now she teaches at the Music Institute of Chicago in Evanston and Winnetka.
